- One activity must be related to either Option for the Poor and Vulnerable or Life and Dignity of the Human Person. Please do not use Room in the Inn for your summer activities. We plan to serve Room in the Inn in groups this winter.
- Service activities may not involve fundraising for teams or class trips.
- Service activities may not be those that are done for teams, scout troops or done during the school day.
- Service forms must be signed by a **non-parent** supervisor.

Sponsor Information

Please complete the following to help us prepare for Confirmation. A sponsor must be 16 years of age and be an active, confirmed Catholic in good standing with the Church. Ideally, candidates choose a godparent. However, we recognize that sometimes that is not possible. The sponsor should be someone that the candidate chooses and someone with whom the candidate feels comfortable discussing their faith. If a candidate chooses a sponsor who cannot be present at the celebration of Confirmation, a proxy who meets the same criteria may stand in for the sponsor. Sponsors should not be parents of the candidate.

Note: Sponsors must provide a letter from their home parish, if it is not CTK, signed by the pastor or his designee, stating that he/she meets these requirements.
